



MEDIA ACCREDITATION AND SAFETY RULES

We kindly invite you to get acquainted with the accreditation and safety provisions of the Baltic 4H Endurance Championship (BEC4H) final round taking part on October 15th in Riga, Bikernieki racetrack. Please fill in the accreditation form carefully. Incorrect or incomplete accreditation forms may not be considered.

1. By applying for accreditation media representative undertakes properly and correctly inform the audience about the event both before and after the event.
2. At the request of the representative of the race organizer, the media is required to provide additional information about the media or represent publications of the event the media representative has visited.
3. Media accreditation form to the Baltic 4H Endurance Championship final round in Bikernieki racetrack, Latvia must be submitted until 13th of October 2017, by filling in the electronic form.
4. The completed accreditation form does not guarantee the granting of accreditation.
5. Incomplete or incorrectly completed media accreditation form may not be considered.
6. Media accreditation is intended only for media representatives: journalists, photographers and cameramen, as well as team representatives – photographers, cameramen.
7. All accredited media representatives will have permission to enter Paddock.
8. All photographers and cameramen who wish to become accredited, must have:
 - a) Existing life insurance policy of at least EUR 1425, - respectively.
 - b) The media tabard that will be possible to get with exchange for guarantee fee of EUR 30, -
9. Received media tabards are forbidden to give to other persons.
10. Media tabard must be worn and the number of the tabard must be visible at all times.
11. Accredited media representative have to follow the instructions of the officials, security guards and marshals.
12. Media, as well as team representatives shall be allowed to stay and move only the appropriate security zones, following the track safety rules and given track scheme (media movement scheme).





13. Only accredited photographers and cameramen with media tabards have right to be presented in the appropriate security zones in the track.
14. For accredited journalists who do not have media tabard it is prohibited to visit the appropriate media security zones in the track.
15. It's forbidden to cross the track during the race.
16. In case of breaking accreditation or track safety rules, the accreditation can be canceled.
17. Accreditation is considered within 5 working days.
18. Accreditation approval or rejection will be sent electronically to the representative's e-mail address, latest until 13th of October.
19. By completing the accreditation form, media representative confirms that he has reached the age of 18, and assumes full responsibility for your life and health during the race.
20. By completing the accreditation form, media representative certifies that all the information provided in this form is correct.

Media accreditation and media tabards can be collected during the racing day at the Media coordinator (located next to the Gate No8 in the Ticket shop). Leaving the event tabard must be returned to the Media coordinator or at the secretariat (building inside the track next to the start-finish line).
