NATIONS CUP REGULATIONS 2021

December, 2020

I. General Conditions

- A. BaTCC Nations Cup series is a regional circuit racing series consisting of Baltic Touring Car Championship (BaTCC), Baltic 6h Endurance Championship (BEC 6H) and Nankang Endurance Academy (NeA 2h).
- B. BaTCC Nations Cup series will be run in compliance with the FIA International Sporting Code (Code) and is handled by the promoters of BaTCC in association with the respective ASN's Racing Commissions or their representatives within the Baltic States.
- C. These are the Sporting Regulations for BaTCC Nations Cup. These Regulations come into force from the moment they are published on the official web-site: www.batcc.eu where possible changes, bulletins etc, will also be published.
- D. The competitors are enforced to follow these Regulations, Supplementary Regulations of each round, Technical Regulations of all participating classes and regulations, bulletins and appendices set by the promoter of the series.
- E. All drivers, competitors and officials participating in the BaTCC Nations Cup series undertake, on behalf of themselves, their employees and agents, to observe all the provisions of the Code, as supplemented or amended the Circuit General Prescriptions, the Technical Regulations, the present Regulations and the Supplementary Regulations of each round will not claim the organizers and/or promoters for any damages or harm to his property or health made during BaTCC Nations Cup events.

II. Dates and circuits of the Events

ROUND 2	Riga, "Bikernieki", Latvia MAY 14-16
ROUND 3	Parnu, "Auto24ring", Estonia JUNE 11-13
ROUND 4	Parnu, "Auto24ring", Estonia AUGUST 21-23
ROUND 5	Riga, "Bikernieki", Latvia SEPTEMBER 17-19

Circuit descriptions will be specified in the Supplementary regulations of each round.

Series promoter reserves the right to change the date of any round or cancel it with a notice 4 weeks before the date of the event published on the official web page of the series: www.batcc.eu

III. Competitors

1. Competitors must be in possession of an appropriate valid ASN issued racing and/or competitor's license (if available).
2. ASN Licenses will be checked during sporting checks in every BaTCC Nations Cup event.
3. All necessary documentation must be presented for checking at all rounds when signing-on.
4. Competitors must ensure that their cars comply with the conditions of eligibility and safety throughout BaTCC Nations Cup events.
5. Each competitor has the right to participate in different events and in different or several classes of BaTCC Nations Cup subject of the competitor being in compliance with the requirements of these Regulations.
6. Each competitor or driver, who complies with the requirements of these Regulations has the right to change the class (on its own risk) till the end of the official time for Sporting Checks, whereas after that moment, it is not allowed to make any changes in the entry whatsoever.
7. Each driver, while participating in any BaTCC Nations Cup event abroad from its country of origin, must have a valid (in case of any accidents during the event) health insurance policy.

IV. Classes

1. All kinds of sports cars may be registered for the BaTCC Nations Cup events provided they are in conformity with the Technical Regulations of the respective class and/or category.
2. All cars taking part in BaTCC Nations Cup events must be clean and without visible damage to the body.

VI. Series classification and points scoring

1. Every participant who has registered for the 2021 season is eligible to collect points for the country that has issued his racing license.

2. For BEC 6H and NeA 2h Championships, collected points by the participant will count towards the country where the BEC 6H and/or NeA 2h team is registered.
3. Points from every category in IV.3 are counted in Nations Cup standings.
4. Only the two best results of each Country participant in the respective category of each race during the events will count in the Nations Cup standings.
5. Every actually held round will count towards the Nations Cup standings.
6. If the class has two races, every race will count towards the Nations Cup standings.
7. At the end of each round, every classified BaTCC Nations Cup registered Competitor will be awarded with the following number of points per respective class:

8. If two or more Countries finish the season with the same number of points, reached place in the overall standing will be shared between the Countries.
9. The official overall classification will be published after each BaTCC event in the official web page of BaTCC (www.batcc.eu). Results published in the official web page of BaTCC (www.batcc.eu) are the only valid results subject to any amendments which may be made under the FIA Code and/or these Regulations.
10. Participants reaching the place 26th and below in the race will collect no points towards Nations Cup.

11. DNS (did not started), DNF (did not finish) and DSQ (disqualified) participants will collect no points towards Nations Cup.

VII. Title and awards

1. The TOP3 countries in the Nations Cup Standings will be awarded with cups at GALA Awards Ceremony 2021
2. All awards are to be provided by the promoter of BaTCC Promoter team and/or by the organizers of the BaTCC Nations Cup events.

VIII. Final provisions

1. The series promoter reserves the right to make any changes to the Regulations for reasons of force majeure, safety or prospective legislation.
2. The BaTCC Nations Cup events and parts thereof, including Regulations, are property of the Promoter of the series therefore usage of it without written confirmation by the promoter is strictly prohibited and any such actions establishes liability for a civil action and may give rise to criminal prosecution in accordance with the legislation of the Republic of Latvia.
