

BULLETIN No 2 to BaTCC Sporting Regulations 2025

New class - "GT AM+"

Legal grounds:

- o BaTCC Sporting Regulations 2025, paragraph #4.2.;
- Written approval from all BaTCC series registered participants for the subject matter;

Based on the rights granted in accordance with the paragraph #4.2. of the BaTCC Sporting Regulations 2025, BaTCC Organizing Committee is making the following decision:

- 1. To launch a new racing class **GT AM+** which to become legitimate for the whole 2025 BaTCC racing series.
- 2. The new racing class will be created by splitting existing racing class in two: GT AM and GT AM+ and the appropriate Bulletin in the Baltic Touring Car technical regulations must be issued simultaneously.
- 3. This decision to become valid as from the moment it is confirmed and accepted by at least 4 (four) BaTCC Organizing Committee.
- 4. The already gained points in the BaTCC racing season 2025, for the rounds No 1 and No 2 will be recalculated accordingly:
