



## DeWALT Grand Prix 2025 - Bikernieki Circuit, Latvia

#### **Pit Lane Access Control**

- Strictly Controlled Area: Only licensed drivers, team members with official credentials, and designated staff may enter the pit lane.
- Zero Tolerance for Unauthorized Access: Any unauthorized presence will result in immediate removal and potential sanctions.
- No Scooters, Bicycles, or Similar Devices: The use of scooters, skateboards, hoverboards, and similar equipment is strictly prohibited in the pit lane, paddock, and garage areas.
- Safety First: This measure is in place to prevent accidents and ensure safe pedestrian traffic.
- Electric Vehicle Charging is Not Allowed On-Site: Charging of electric vehicles is forbidden in all areas of the venue to prevent fire hazards.
- Follow Signage and Permits: Park only in designated areas and display the correct parking permit.
- Towing Policy: Vehicles found in unauthorized zones or lacking proper permits will be towed at the owner's expense without prior notice.

### **General Behavior Expectations**

- Respect All Event Officials: Participants and attendees must follow the instructions of race directors, marshals, stewards, and security personnel at all times.
- Disciplinary Action: Non-compliance may lead to penalties, disqualification, or removal from the premises.
- Be Respectful: Treat all fellow participants, staff, and spectators with courtesy and respect.
- Keep Areas Clean: Dispose of waste properly and help maintain a clean environment.
- No Aggressive Behavior: Aggressive language, threats, or violence will not be tolerated.
- Photography & Filming: Follow any restrictions on media use and always respect privacy and safety.

### **Fire Safety Equipment**

- Fire Safety Compliance: All teams and attendees are expected to follow these fire safety protocols without exception.
- Mandatory Fire Extinguishers: Every participant is required to have a fire extinguisher accessible at their paddock area or garage.
- Usability Requirement: The extinguisher must be operational and easily usable by any person nearby in the event of an emergency.

#### Access to paddock

The main gate opening and closing times. The barrier will shut the car traffic, but it will be accessible on foot.

- 04.06 from 22:00
- 05.06 gate opens 7:00, closes 23:00

- 06.06 gate opens 7:00, closes 23:00
- 07.06 gate opens 7:00, closes 1:00
  Parking pass for participants will give access to parking next to the gates.
  One paddock pass for cars will be issued for every participant.
